Covid-19 Update

As I'm sure you are aware, the Prime Minister has confirmed the next stage of the Roadmap out of lockdown which is effective from Monday 17th May. This was accompanied by new guidance from the Department for Education. The guidance largely remains unchanged, meaning we will continue to operate in the same way as we have this term; with staggered start and finish times children remaining in class bubbles and masks being worn by staff, visitors and parents in the playgrounds and communal areas around school.

All of our current health & safety measures will remain in place including:

- self isolating if symptoms are displayed
- Cleaning hands thoroughly and more often than usual
- Following the 'catch it, kill it, bin it' approach
- Enhanced cleaning and ventilation within all areas of the school
- Maintaining social distancing were possible
