School Meal Update

A reminder for children who have moved from Year 2 to Year 3 will no longer qualify for Universal Infant Free School Meals and meals should be paid for via Parentpay.

In KS2 (Years 3,4,5,& 6) school meals must be paid for in advance. Parents should ensure there is sufficient funds in their ParentPay account BEFORE their child requests a lunch.

Due to increasing costs, the price of our school meals will be increasing to £2.40 from Monday 31st October 2022


