Covid-19 Lateral Flow Tests & Reporting Over Easter

Covid-19 Symptoms and Lateral Flow (LFD) Testing

Lateral flow (LFD) testing at home is now available to all households with school aged children. This testing is to identify asymptomatic cases of COVID-19 and **should not** be used on individuals with symptoms.

Anyone with symptoms of COVID-19, even if they have recently had a negative LFD test result, should take a PCR test (either via a postal test or at a test site) to check if they have the virus. Until a negative **PCR** test result is received, the whole household must self-isolate and your child(ren) should not attend school.

Reporting of Positive Cases Over Easter

If your child tests positive for COVID-19 and their symptoms began within 2 days of being in school, you must email office@uva.clf.uk as soon as possible. This is to ensure we can inform possible contacts as quickly as possible. Please continue to report if your child tests positive or has been in contact with someone who tests positive, throughout the Easter break to office@uva.clf.uk. Please confirm the date the symptoms started, the date of the test and the date of last contact (if applicable).

As per our letter issued to Year 3/4 parents this week, swimming lessons for those classes that were postponed in term 2 and term 3 will now go ahead.


