Trophy Return

Absence Reporting

Can we remind all parents that if your child is ill and cannot attend school, the procedure for reporting an absence is to telephone the absence line on 01934 626769 and choose option 2 before 9.00am every day.

Many parents are informing staff at the school gate and assuming this is sufficient. The procedure above MUST be followed **every day** your child is absent.

Calling the absence line with an explanation as to why your child cannot attend school that day is essential.

End of Year ParentPay

Year 6 Children

Can parents of our Year 6 children please be aware that money held in 'My Account' within ParentPay will remain in your account and will transfer with your child to their new school, if they use ParentPay.

Any monies assigned to specific charges within Uphill Village Academy i.e. lunches, breakfast club and after school club cannot be transferred back to 'My Account' once your child has left. Any credit in an account can be transferred to a siblings account if requested.

Year 6 children attending Breakfast Club & After School Club should have sufficient funds available to pay for their bookings for July before bookings can be confirmed

All Other Year Groups

Any child currently attending school and having school dinners in July must have enough credit within their account to cover the costs. Please remember to top up your account at the end of August to cover any meal costs in September. All balances MUST remain in credit at all times. Parents of children within Year 2 should be aware that the entitlement for Universal Infant Free School Meals will cease and school meals will be charged to ParentPay at a cost of £2.20 per meal.

After School Club & Breakfast Club

June fees are now available for payment. All balances MUST be cleared by 6th July in full. Failure to clear any outstanding balance will lead to bookings after this date being cancelled.

Whole School French Day (lunch menu change)

On Thursday 14th July, we will be relaunching our teaching of French for the whole academy. Children will enjoy a day full of activities exploring French culture, French artists and French language.

Part of the planned day is a French school lunch which will be served in a French café style, with tricolour bunting and Parisienne music.

It is also an opportunity to celebrate all languages spoken from our varied community.


