Uniform Expectations

Presentation is important and we expect children to attend school wearing of correct uniform. This includes wearing appropriate footwear.

Polishable school shoes are expected to be worn. Trainers are NOT allowed unless they are fully black (no logos or other colours)

With the onset of Winter, boots can be worn but school shoes should be brought into school to change into on arrival. Ankle boots are allowed but ONLY in plain black & should not have buckles or embellishments.

If you are struggling financially with the purchasing of school uniform, please speak to the school office team in confidence.
