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Message from the Principal

Dear Parents & Carers,

As you are aware we have had a confirmed case of Covid-19 within school and some of our children are isolating as a result of this. I am very aware of the disruption this causes to school, work and family life and would like to take this opportunity to thank parents for their continued support during this time.

I would like to remind all parents that if your child is unwell with a cough, temperature or a loss of taste or smell, they and any sibling, must not attend school and you need to book a PCR test at a test centre. May I also remind parents that lateral flow tests are for asymptomatic people only; those with no symptoms.

If your child is poorly, we would recommend they remain at home to be monitored and only return when they are well enough. This will help stop the spread of other viruses which are circulating. If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea they need to remain at home for 48 hours after the last bout.

On a happier note, we are looking forward to our Year 4 residential camp next week; have fun Year 4! Our Year 5/6 children are busy preparing their end of year production, which will be recorded for parents and uploaded to our new YouTube channel. Our Year 2 children had a fab time at their virtual Summer Sing event this week; we were joined by other schools virtually for a brilliant sing-a-long. Finally, we're delighted that we have 12 feathery new additions to EYFS & Year 1. The eggs the children have enjoyed nurturing have hatched and we have 12 chicks to care for instead - well done EYFS & Year 1.

As many of you are aware, our video centre, was connected to our old website and we can no longer upload any new videos to the site.


