Wrap Around Care

As many of you are aware, our After School Club & Breakfast Club facilities are very busy and the demand often exceeds the number of places we have available.

We know this is frustrating for some parents but we do operate a waiting list and try to accommodate as many children as we can.

We have a few parents who are over booking places and then cancelling them a week before to avoid charges. We kindly ask that parents refrain from doing this as this may deprive another family of a place.

A few things to remember:

Breakfast Club arrival is before 8:00am please.

After School Club collections are 4:00pm, 5:00pm, 5:30pm & 6:00pm. Club is often outside & staff cannot answer the bell at other times.

Please collect promptly. Late collections mean a member of staff is not available for club & children can be waiting in the cold weather.

Late Arrivals

Our school day operates from 8.45am until 3.15pm. We have had an increasing number of children arriving regularly after the gates close at 8.45am or not being collected at 3.15pm when the school day ends.

Punctuality is a lifeskill that we should model to our children and ensure they understand the importance of it. Arriving late can be disruptive to both lessons & the children concerned. Please give yourselves an extra five minutes in the morning to arrive at school before 8:45am.

We understand that occasionally things happen to delay collections at pick up time, however repeated late collection may lead to children having to attend After School Club and charges made for this. We hope parents understand we do not have the resources to provide childcare.

Uphill Village Academy has a school uniform because, we believe, it helps to set the right learning attitudes in school. It is a leveller of individuals and is good value for money. Your child is required to wear the correct uniform at all times. It has been noted that a number of children, especially in the Year 5 & 6 cohort, are coming to school without the correct uniform on.

Rules for Wearing School Uniform

- School uniform should be worn with pride at all times. Uniform should be clean and well presented.
 - Jewellery is not permitted, except plain stud earrings and a wrist watch.
 - Nail varnish and make-up are not permitted. Hair must be tied back from the face.
- Pupils are not allowed to wear trainers, except for PE, unless they are plain black and polishable with no logos. Shoes, including sandals, must strap securely to the feet.
 - Leggings are only to be worn with a skirt over them, they are not suitable as a replacement for trousers.
 - Socks should not be worn over leggings.

Please ensure your child complies with the uniform rules every day.
