Thank you to those parents who gave their feedback on how you found your child's Parents Evening.

Overall, the feedback was very positive and we are always delighted to read such supportive comments letting us know about the things we are getting right. However, we are always keen to make our Parents Evenings as informative as possible and will be taking your suggestions and reviewing our processes for the next evenings in the Spring term.

There were some common themes from the feedback:

- The appointments are for 10 minutes, as this allows every parent to have an opportunity to see their child's class teacher. Follow up appointments can be arranged with the class teacher if parents have a specific issue that needs to be discussed further.
- The majority of parents have expressed preference for the continuation of the hybrid approach, so we will offer both face-to-face & video calls in the Spring.
