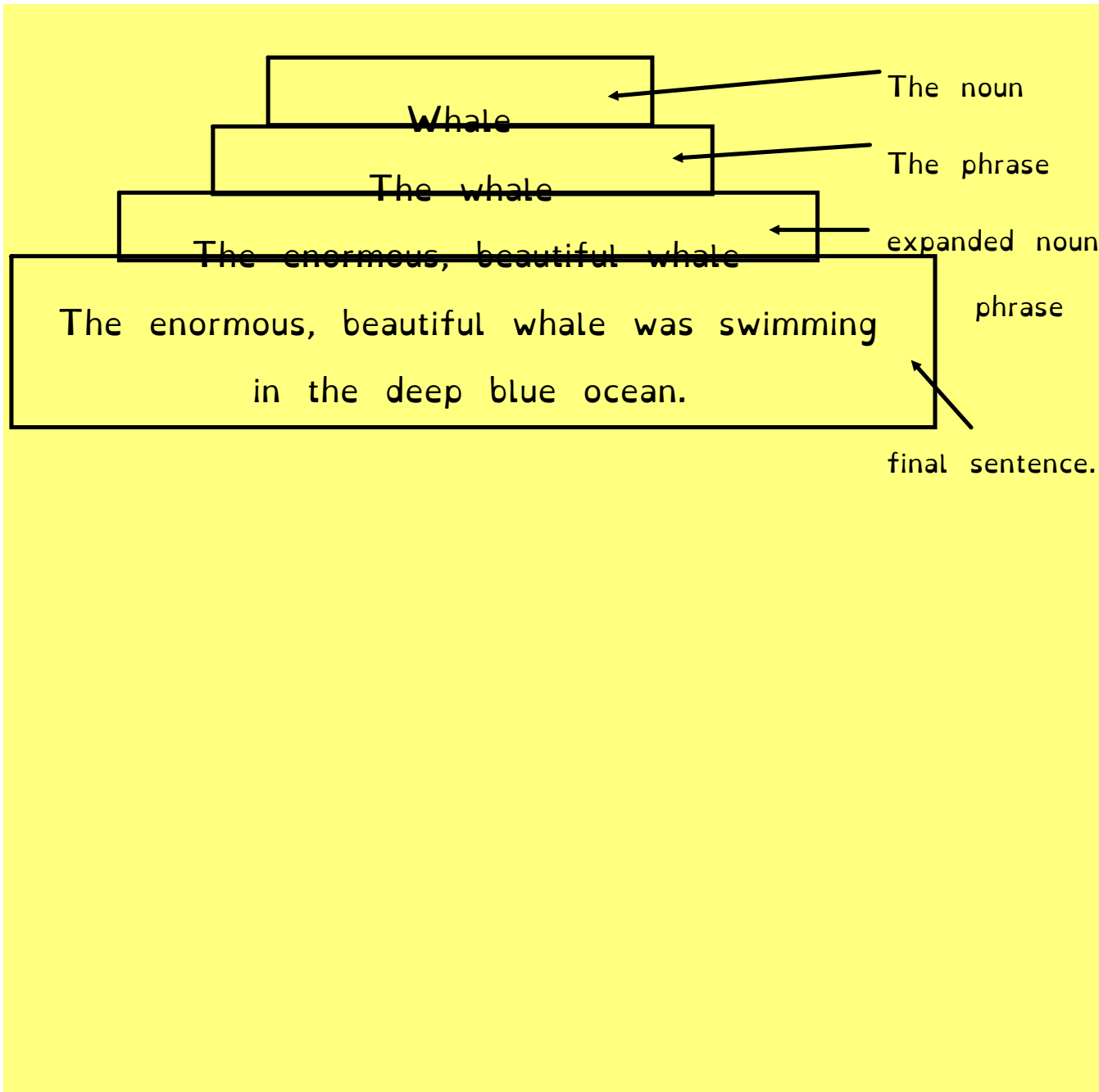


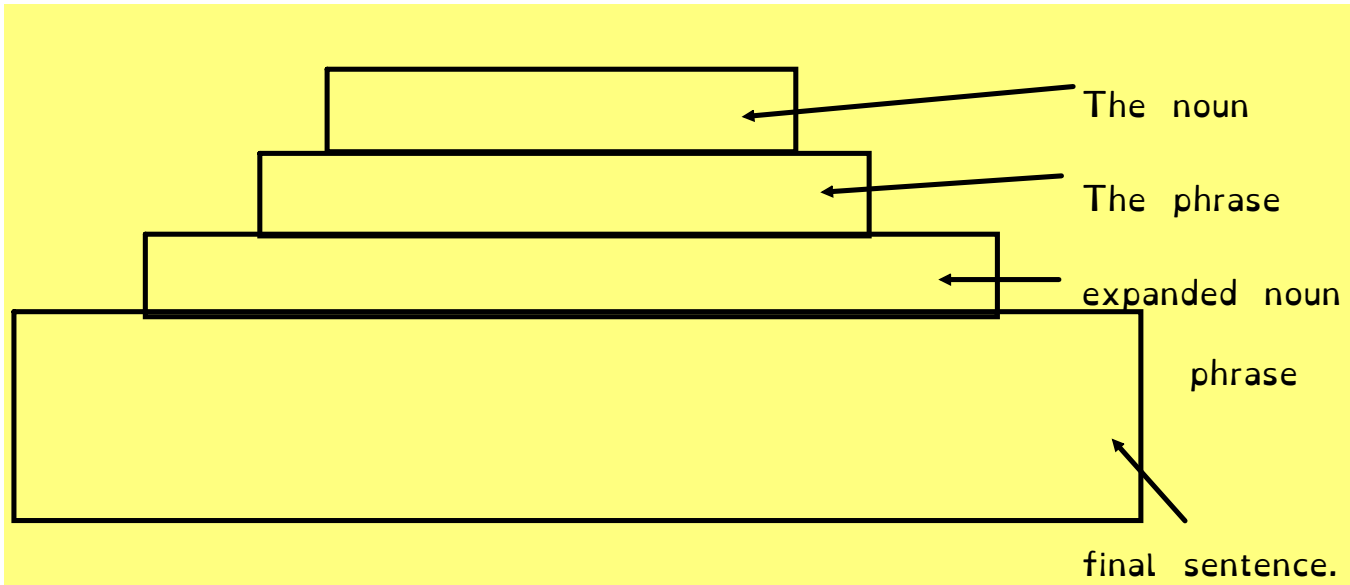
An expanded noun phrase

These make noun phrases more interesting by adding adjectives (describing words).

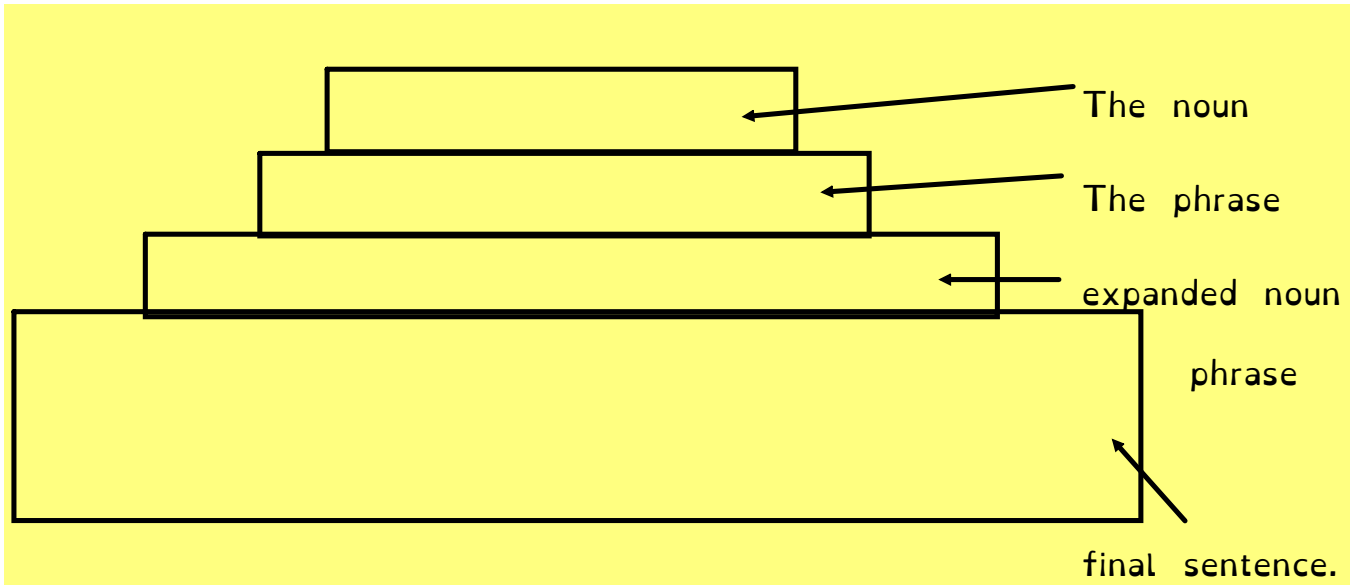
It helps the reader imagine exactly what the author is writing about.
