Magnetic letters or written letter cards to make: wait, aim, main, mail, rain, tail. Letters needed- a, i, w, m, n, l, t	Segmenting for spelling- quick write: wait, hail, pain, aim, sail, main, tail, rain, bait.	Blending 'ee' words- see, feet, meet, keep, deep. Segmenting 'ee' words using phoneme frames- cheep, sheep, teeth, sheet.	Ask children to write down sounds 'sh,' 'ng', 'ai,' 'ee'. Say a word and children have to point at the correct phoneme. 'shop, feet, pain, shell, hang, long, hail, deep, (or NESW if in classroom)
Apply	Children to write their own sentence with a noun and verb. (Maybe give list of options- ring, chips, shed, moth, long, red, fat)	Write: We got wet in the rain.	Blending for reading- Caption reading: I will wait for a taxi, The cat has a long tail, I sang a song in the rain.
