Find a song online to learn about the planets



Experiment making music with water. Fill containers with different amounts of water. What sounds are made. Which are low? Which are high?

It's fun to colour the water. This also means that you can write down any tunes you make – e.g. play red, green, red, red, blue



Use cardboard tubes to make a xylophone – watch a video clip of someone playing the xylophone.

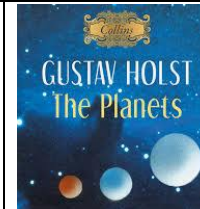


Listen to or watch a clip of people playing pan pipes.
Make Drinking Straw Pan pipes.



Recycle some empty bottles or jars and explore the sounds made by filling them with different objects to make shakers. Try pasta, rice, coins, buttons, cereal, sand.

Can your child describe the sounds/identify how they are different?
