













EYFS/Year 1 Project Activities for Home Learning TERM 3

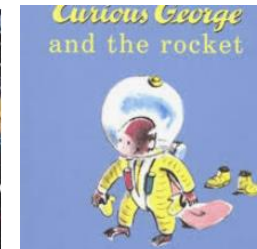
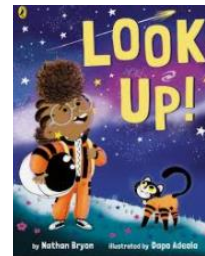
