and raced out of the door to discover...



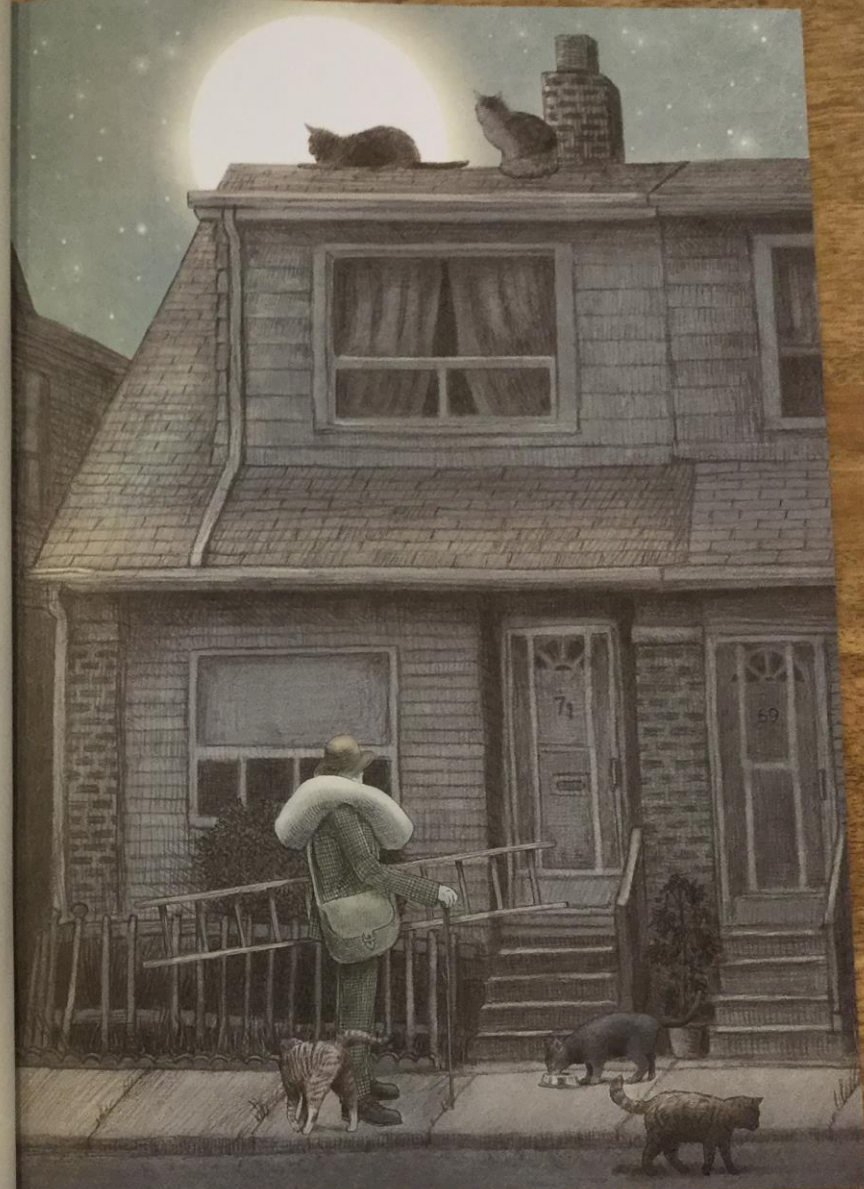


a wise owl had appeared overnight, as if by magic.

with a sense of excitement.



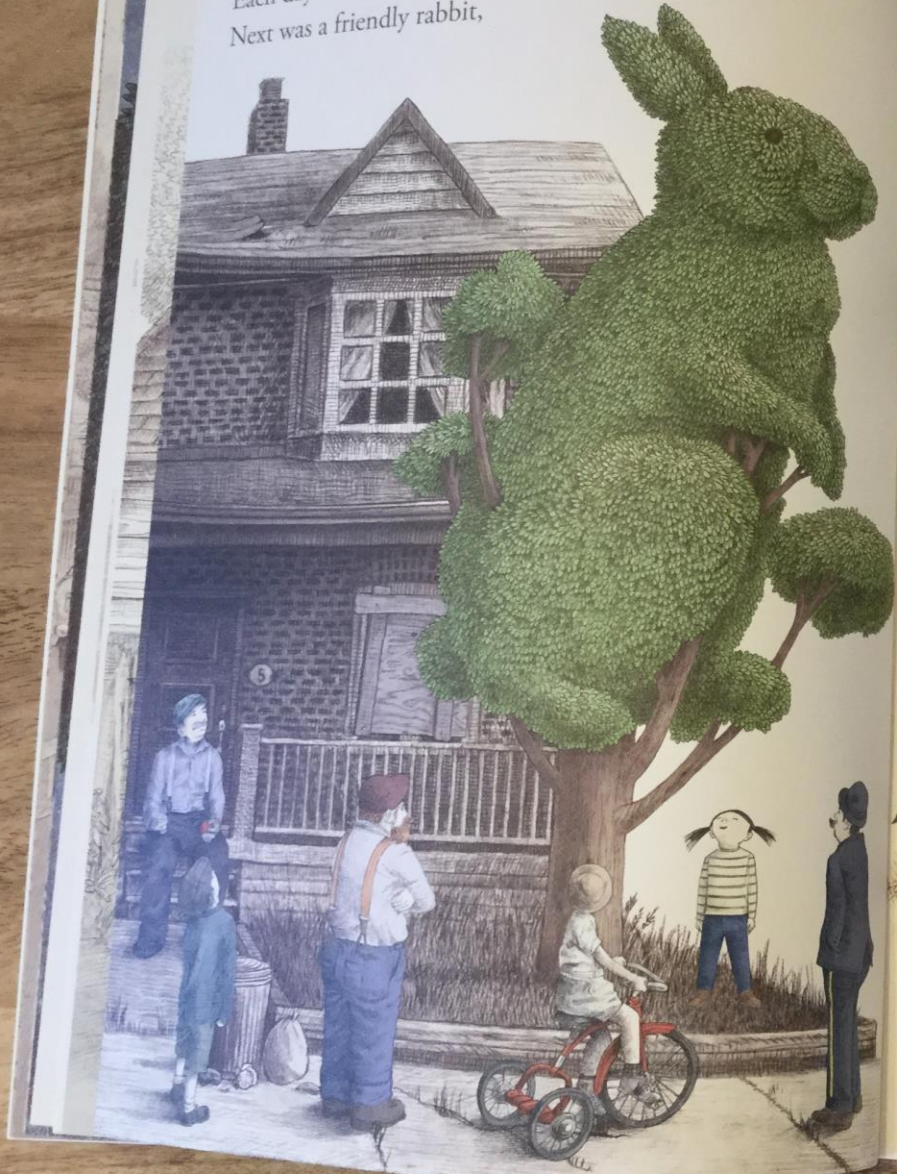

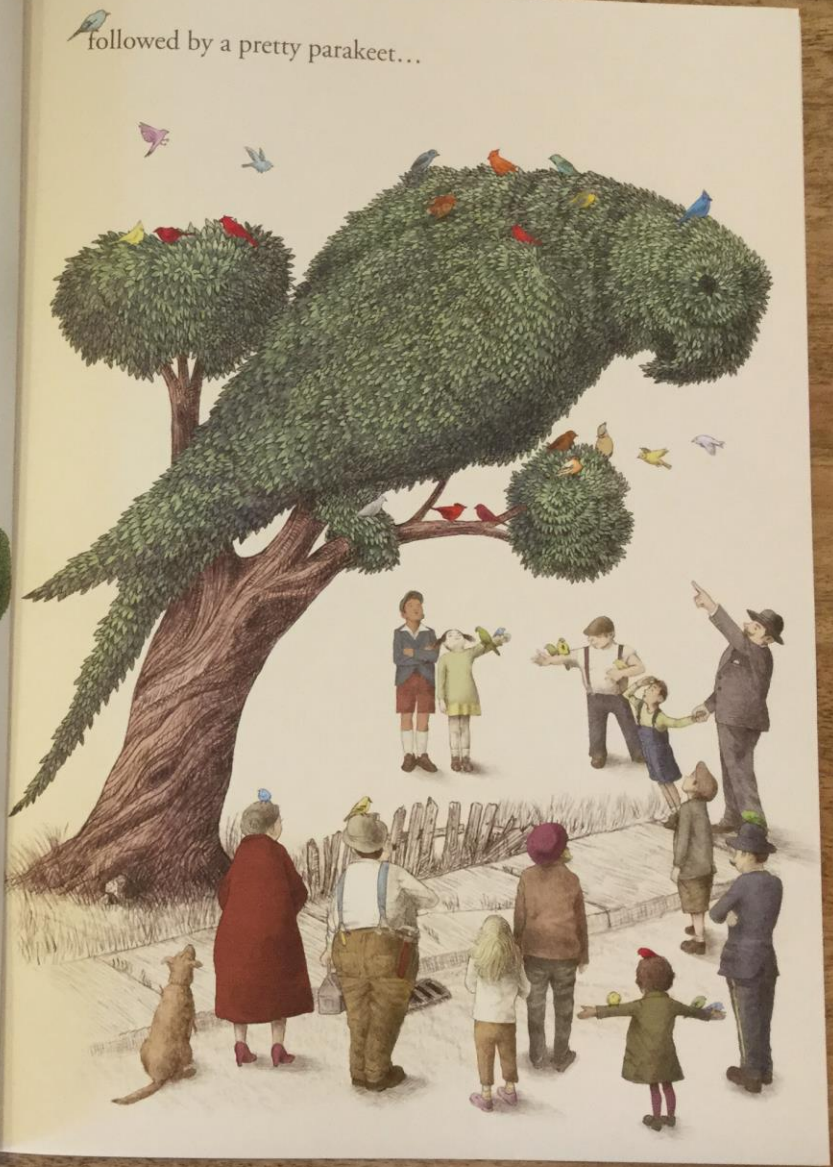
William was not disappointed.



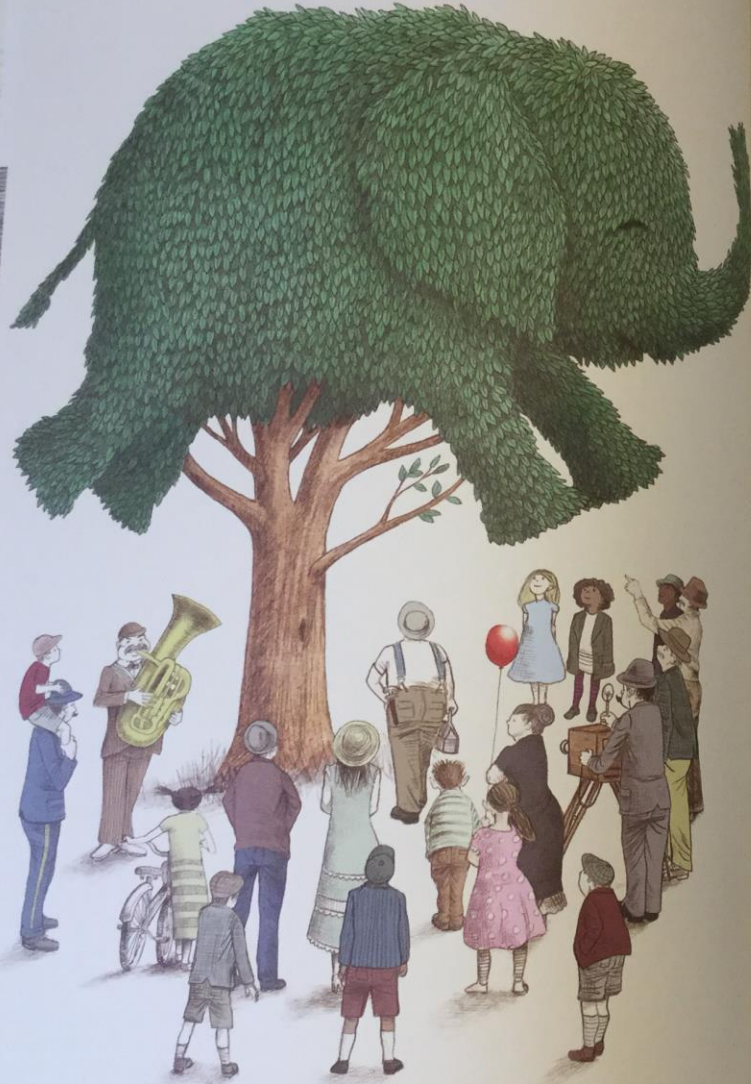
Each day William discovered a new topiary.

followed by a pretty parakeet...

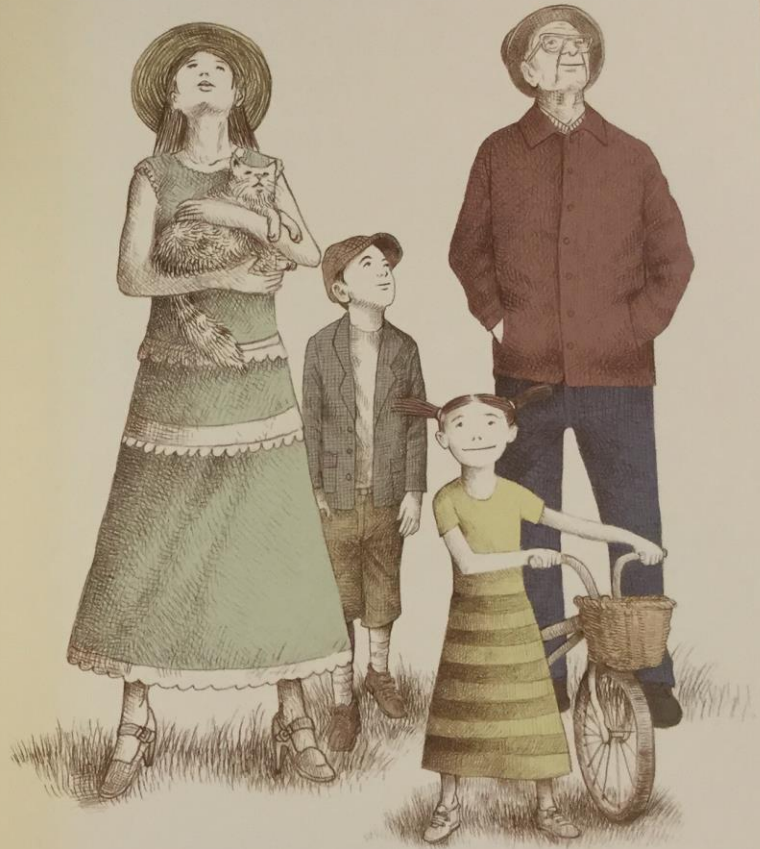


and then a playful elephant.



With each new sculpture, the crowds grew and grew.

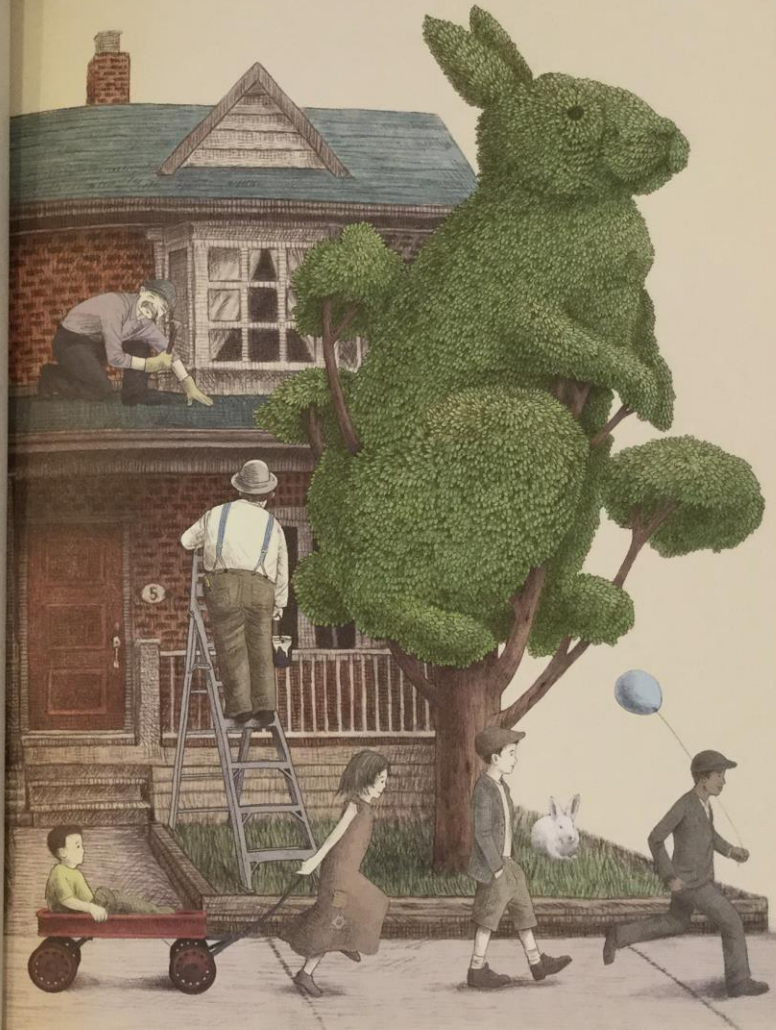
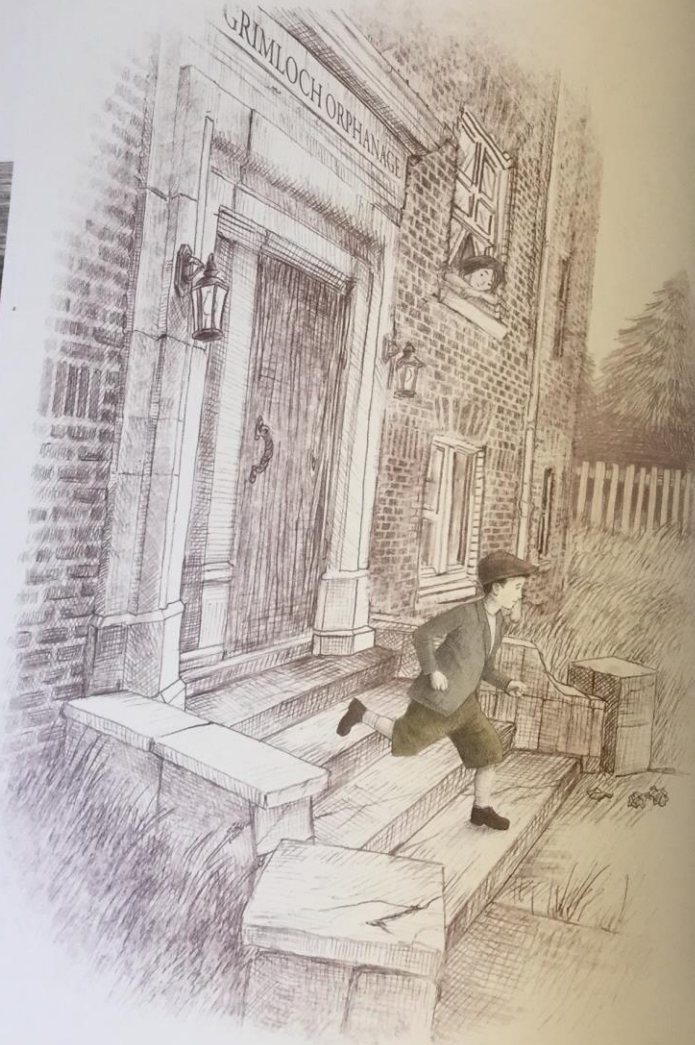

and followed the crowds, only to find...

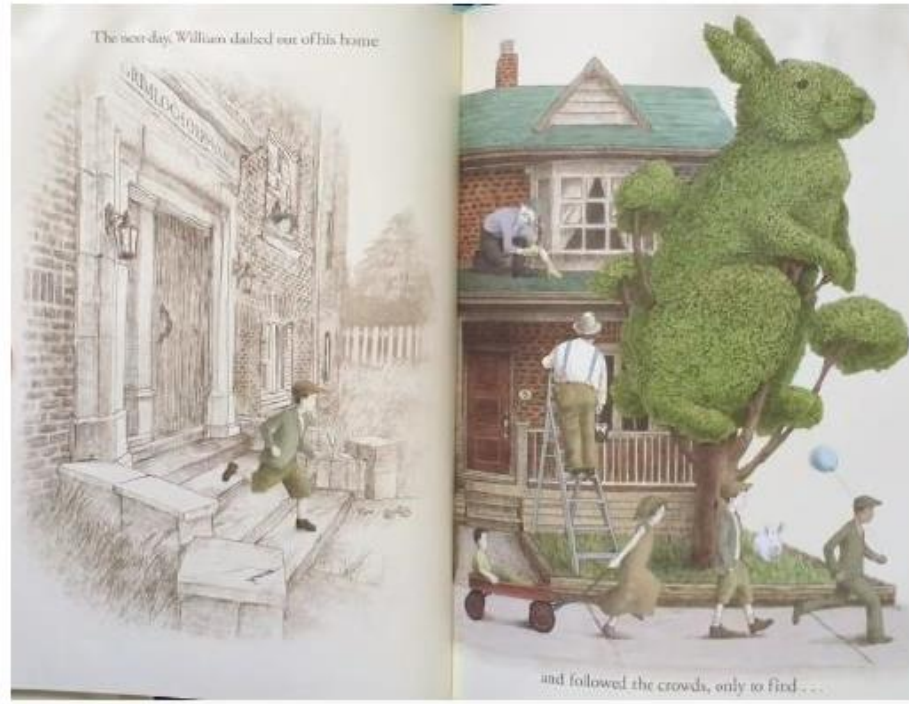
