- ▶ How do you think William feels about the commotion on the street? Why do you think this?



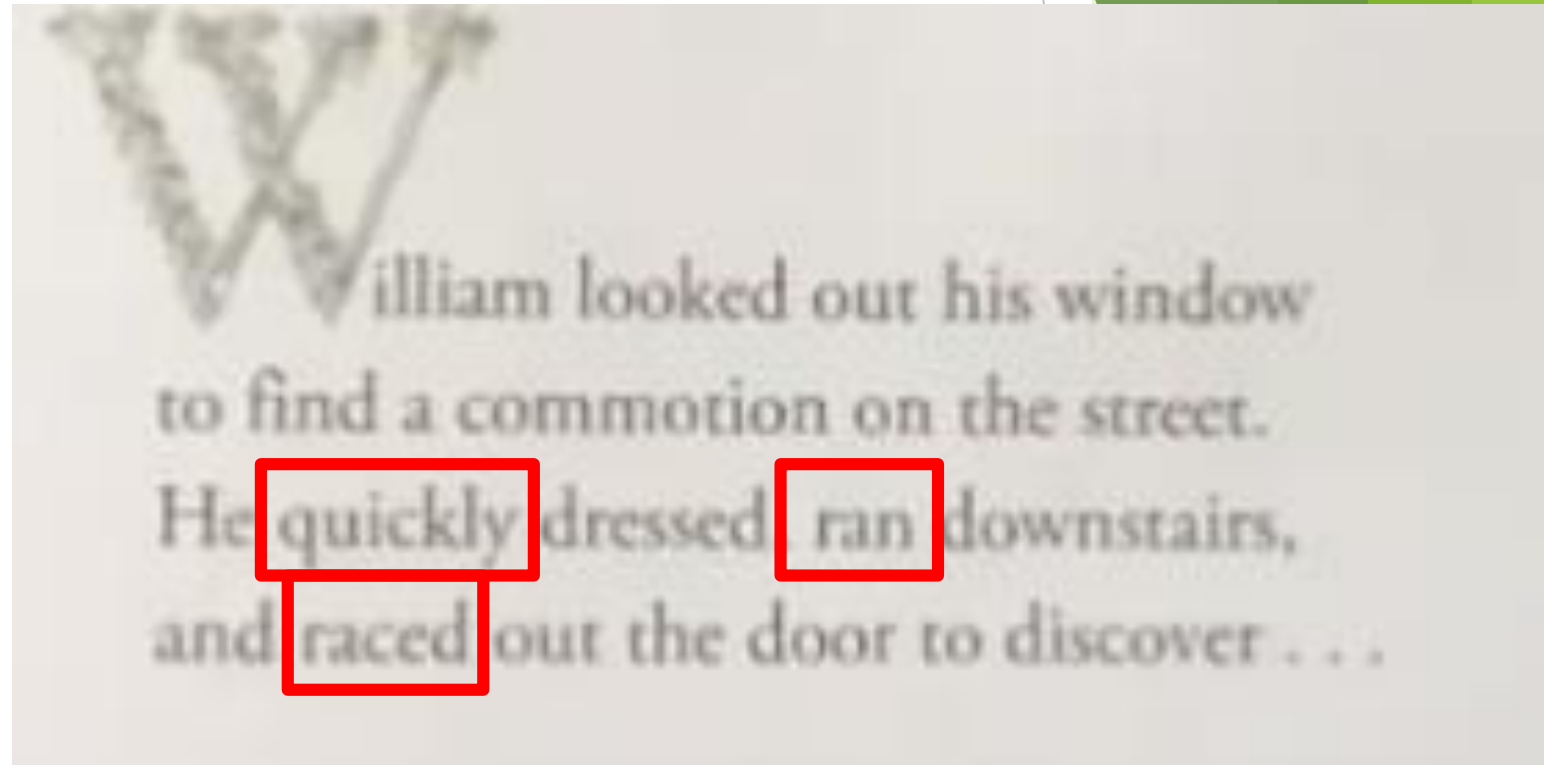
