Climate

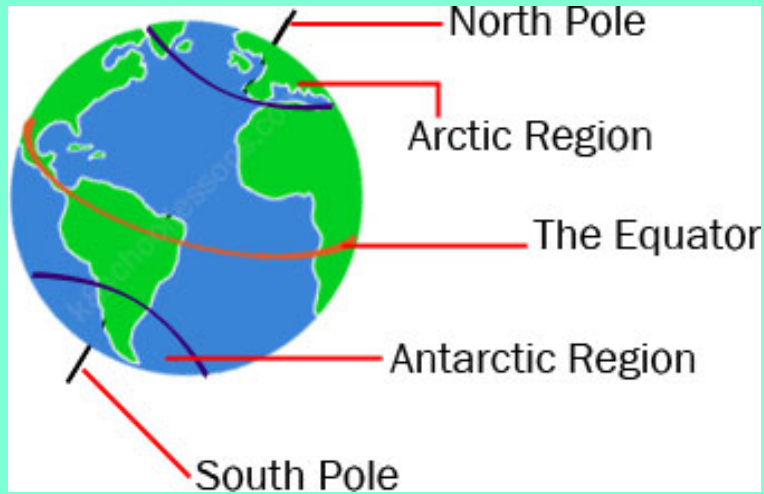
Climate is the average weather usually taken over 30 years for a particular place.

Is it hot / cold / changeable?

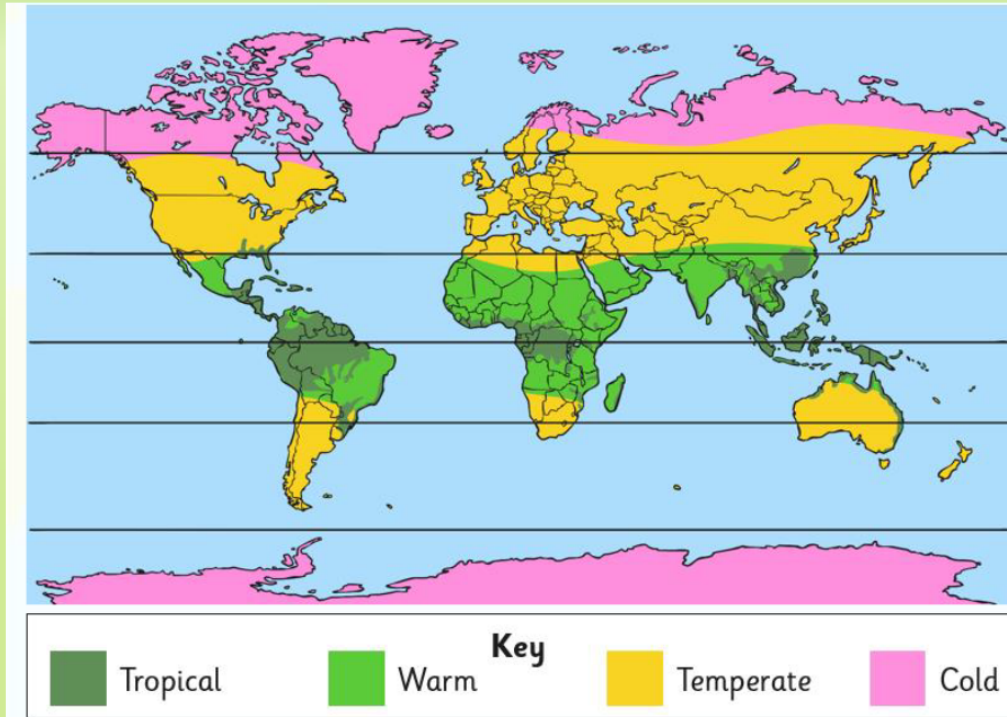
What would you like our weather to be like?

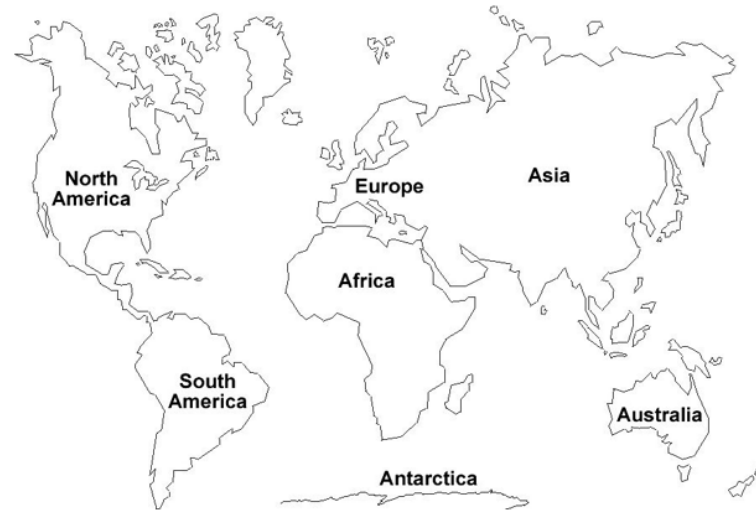

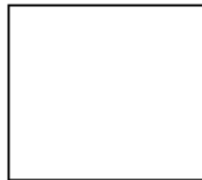
