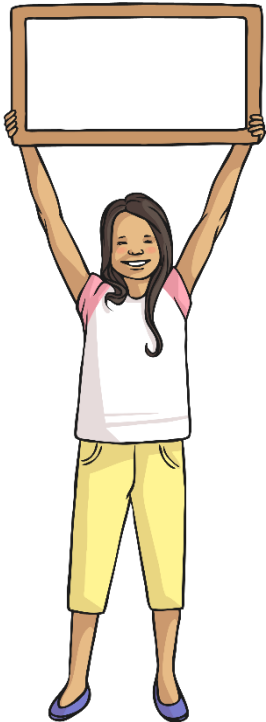

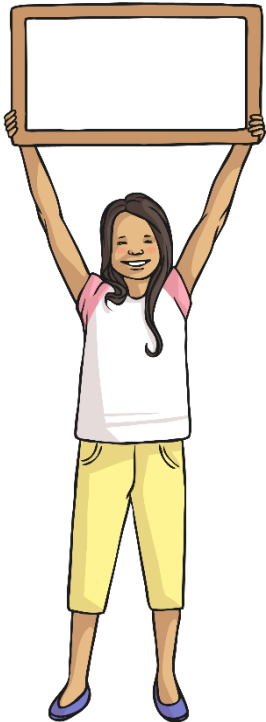

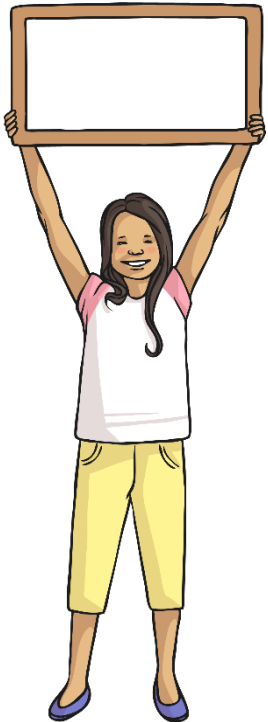

# Past Tense

We would also add the suffix -ed to some words to use them in the past tense.



walk

stay

stop

scare

play

push

walked

stayed

stopped

scared

played

pushed





# Present Tense

Present tense words change depending on the sentence they are in.

They either have no suffix, -ing suffix or -s/-es suffix.

play

playing

plays

Jimmy is **playing** with his friend John.

Lucy wakes up and **plays** with her dolls.

I love to **play** football.
