# WELCOME TO YEAR 5

Learning without Limits

## Uniform

- Uniform policy still holds - please help us to ensure all children are dressed appropriately

- paper arithmetic homework (Thursday to Thursday)
- Spelling Frame (Monday to Monday) - paper spelling test completed in school on Mondays
- Read Theory will be completed at school - children can complete extra at home, but this will be optional
